Active ingredients:

Each 1mL of liquid contains:

Matricaria chamomilla (Chamomile) ext. dry conc 10mg. Equiv. to dry flower 100mg

Melissa officinalis (Lemon Balm) ext. dry conc 6.75mg. Equiv. to dry flower & leaves 67.5mg

Dill Seed Oil 0.12mg

Also contains:

Citric acid, glycerol, potassium sorbate, purified water, xanthan gum.

This product is available in a 100mL bottle.

1. Indication

Infants' Friend Colic & Wind has been formulated to relieve colic (wind/gas pain), restless sleep and symptoms of indigestion in babies, based on the traditional use of the active ingredients in Western herbal medicine. Infants' Friend can be used from birth onwards.

2. Traditional uses

Matricaria chamomilla (Chamomile): Traditionally used in Western herbal medicine to help relieve symptoms of infant colic.

Melissa officinalis (Lemon Balm): Traditionally used in Western herbal medicine to relieve restless sleep and symptoms of indigestion.

Dill Seed Oil: Traditionally used in Western herbal medicine to relieve symptoms of indigestion and stomach ache caused by wind and colic.

3. Instructions for use

Shake well before use. Use the syringe provided to draw up the recommended dosage of Oral Liquid. Administer the dosage directly onto the tongue or add to the bottle prior to feeding.

Dosage: Infants' Friend Colic & Wind can be taken with feeds up to six times daily. Do not exceed the recommended dose.

Birth – 1 month: 0.25-0.5mL

1 – 3 months: 0.5-1mL

3 – 6 months: 1-1.5mL

6 – 12 months: 1.5-2.5mL

12 months +: 2.5-4mL

4. Warnings

Contains potassium sorbate. If you think your baby may be allergic to any of the ingredients contained within Infants' Friend Colic & Wind, seek medical advice prior to using.

If symptoms do not improve, seek medical advice.

5. Storage and expiry date

Keep Infants' Friend Colic & Wind out of reach of children. Store below 30°C. Do not use past the expiry date on the bottle and carton.

Always read the label and follow the directions for use.
